II. COURSE NAME: NURSE AIDE I

III. COURSE CODE AND NUMBER: NA 100

IV. COURSE DESCRIPTION:

- This course is designed to provide entry level Nurse Aide students with nurse aide skills essential for providing resident care under the direction and supervision of a nurse. This program is designed to prepare participants to successfully fulfill the requirements for completion for the Nurse Aide I training program and to successfully meet the competency requirements for listing on the Nurse Aide I registry. The course is 132 hours which includes 43.5 hours of lecture, 56.5 hours of lab, and 32 hours of clinical.
- After successful completion of this course, the candidate will be eligible to take the NC Nurse Aide competency exam to become a certified nursing assistant.

V. *Special Admissions Requirements:*

- Must present a High School Diploma or GED Transcript
- Must have a valid Picture ID and Social Security card
- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Must be proficient in English reading, writing, and comprehension
- Must pass a criminal background check
- Must submit proof of required facility vaccinations
- Must have a negative TB test or screening/X-ray within the last year prior to clinical

VIII. GRADING

- The student must pass the theory/lecture component with a 77 (C)
- Clinical and Lab is a pass or fail only
- Students must pass the theory, lab, and clinical to successfully complete the course, if not student will have to re-register for the course and take the course over.

- Homework/activities: 20%
- Exams 60% (Total of 5 Exams – 20% each)
- Final exam: 20%

IX. Attendance

Students can only miss a minimum of 8 hours (2 days) of combined lecture and lab only. It is student's responsibility to complete make-up work and to reach out to the instructor for missed assignments. **All students are required to email the lead instructor when late or absent.**

All missed classroom and laboratory experiences will be made up on assigned make up days for the student to complete the Nurse Aide I Training Program

All clinical training sessions are mandatory. Students are **NOT** allowed to miss or be tardy for any clinical days.
